DEAR STUDENTS,

It has been a little over a year since June 24, 2022, when the Supreme Court's Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade and wiped out the reproductive choice people in the United States had had for 49 years. Dobbs has upended reproductive healthcare in the United States. This film focuses on medical professionals and grassroots activists who began their work before Dobbs and have continued thereafter to fight to make abortion care available in all 50 states by whatever means necessary. Please watch the film, discuss it, learn from passionate changemakers what is possible when people advocate for their rights and their beliefs – and then spread the word in your community.
